JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ACT

WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act "PL97-300" will replace the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act, CETA, on October 1, 1983, at the end of the current transitional fiscal year; and


WHEREAS, for each Service Delivery Area designated by the Government under this program, there must be created a Private Industry Council, PIC, which shall be responsible for developing program policies and a job-training plan, as well as designating its administrative and planning agent and selecting Service Delivery organizations; and

WHEREAS, Counties are assigned a critical role in the process, including responsibilities for organizing the PIC, selecting its members, and receiving and approving the PIC'S programs and plans;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Nassau County that Commissioner Blackwelder is hereby designated to serve with other County Commissioners of the five County (Baker, Clay, Nassau, Putnam, and St. Johns) Service Delivery Area to develop necessary program guidelines and interlocal agreements creating the consortium and the process to establish a PIC, all of which shall be subject to review and approval by each county; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Northeast Florida Regional Planning Council is hereby requested to assist these County Representatives in their assigned task.
