

RESOLUTION 83-23

A RESOLUTION URGING THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA TO AMEND FLORIDA STATUTES 125.0104 TO ALLOW, BUT NOT REQUIRE, THE IMPOSITION OF A LOCAL OPTION TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX WHERE SOME OF THE PROCEEDS COULD BE USED FOR BEACH RENOURISHMENT.

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has provided, by statute, for a "local option" tourist development tax, and

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has provided for the authorized use of the moneys derived from said tax, and

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature does not provide for the use of said revenues for beach renourishment and care, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that the Legislature amend Florida Statutes 125.0104 to authorize the use of the proceeds from said local option tax to be used for beach renourishment and care.
