WHEREAS, The Callahan Junior High Rolling Ramblers have made the Citizens of Nassau County extremely proud by their having completed an undefeated football season, and


WHEREAS, The Callahan Junior High Rolling Ramblers broke four existing school records, and

WHEREAS, in recognition of their outstanding season and contribution to Nassau County, it is hereby





