RESOLUTION 87-16

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REGARDING THE LOFTON CREEK AND WEST NASSAU LANDFILLS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County has been advised by the Department of Environmental Regulations (D.E.R.) that plans for the closure of the above landfills is required, and

WHEREAS, the County does not have the staff to formulate plans required pursuant to Florida Statutes, Chapter 403, and

WHEREAS, the County has contracted with B. H. & R. of Jacksonville, Florida, in order to formulate plans for closure of the landfills, and

WHEREAS, said plans will set forth the financing methods for said closure, and

WHEREAS, said plans shall be available within 120 days.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 30th day of January, 1987, that the Board of County Commissioners hereby Resolves to:

 Submit a detailed plan to D.E.R. outlining closure plans and financing methods. Said plan shall be proposed by B. H. & R. Planning Group and submitted to the Board for their review and approval.

2. Proceed as rapidly as possible with the closure of said landfills, considering the financial constraints of the County both in funding of specific plans and in purchasing additional lands for alternate sites.

3. Insure that all plans shall meet State and Federal requirements.

4. Reassure D.E.R. that the Board of County Commissioners is working diligently in addressing the existing concerns.
