A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF LOCATING THE SUPERCONDUCTING SUPER COLLIDER IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, Nassau County has been selected by the State of Florida to locate the Superconducting Super Collider; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County has all of the natural attributes necessary for the Superconducting Super Collider, including ample supplies of natural water systems, a Hawthorne factor below the surface which is conducive to tunnelling and the construction of the tubing necessary for the Superconducting Super Collider, and further, the land mass required for such a project; and
