

RESOLUTION 88 - 74

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE APPOINTMENT OF MRS. CHARLES PICKETT TO FILL THE REMAINING TERM OF HER HUSBAND, COMMISSIONER CHARLES A. PICKETT.

WHEREAS, Commissioner Charles A. Pickett was elected in 1984 to represent District 5 on the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Charles A. Pickett passed away in office on Wednesday, September 14, 1988; and

WHEREAS, his passing leaves a vacancy until the statutorially designated time in November, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the existing Board of County Commissioners feels it would be in the best interests of the citizens of the County to appoint Mrs. Charles A. Pickett to fill the remainder of her husband's term.
