

RESOLUTION NO. 89-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE NASSAU DISTRICT OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA IN THEIR NATIONAL GOOD TURN PROGRAM KNOWN AS "SCOUTING FOR FOOD" AND URGING THE CITIZENS OF NASSAU COUNTY TO SUPPORT "SCOUTING FOR FOOD" THROUGH THE DONATION OF NON-PERISHABLE FOOD ITEMS.

WHEREAS, 20,000,000 Americans including some 4,000,000 children go hungry some time each month; and

WHEREAS, there are more hungry people in America now than at any time during the last 25 years; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau District, North Florida Council of the Boy Scouts of America will participate in a national good turn simultaneously with other scouters from throughout the nation; and

WHEREAS, the national good turn is known as "Scouting for Food"; and

WHEREAS, November 12, 1988 Nassau County Scouts will distribute bags for food donations; and

WHEREAS, November 19, 1988 Nassau County Scouts will collect donated food items.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, supports the Boy Scouts of Nassau County in their effort to collect food stuffs for distribution to needy residents. In addition, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County recognizes that Scouts participating in the "Scouting for Food" Program will experience the highest ideals of the Scouting movement through an unprecedented act of community stewardship.
