

RESOLUTION 90 - 116

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IMMEDIATELY ADDRESS STATE ROAD 107.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has advised the State that State Road 107 in its present condition, is hazardous to the citizens of Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, the Board has also been advised by the Florida department of Transportation that said road is set for the 1994 fiscal budget; and

WHEREAS, there have been a number of accidents on said road, including a number of deaths; and

WHEREAS, the road improvements should be immediately addressed by the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 9<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1990, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:


1. The Board hereby formally and urgently requests that the Florida Department of Transportation immediately address State Road 107.

2. Immediately addressing State Road 107 should mean that

the Florida Department of Transportation commence work on said road this year.

3. Copies of this Resolution shall be sent to Governor Martinez, Secretary of Transportation, Senator Girardeau, and Representative Crady.
