

RESOLUTION 90 - 55

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE NASSAU COUNTY HAZARDOUS MATERIALS EMERGENCY PLAN.

WHEREAS, Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, assigns to the Board of County Commissioners the responsibility for disaster mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery; and

WHEREAS, with the enactment of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act of 1986, Congress imposed upon Local Emergency Planning Committees and local governments additional planning and preparedness requirements for response to emergencies involving the release of hazardous materials; and

WHEREAS, each County within a Local Emergency Planning District is required to develop an Emergency Response Plan for Hazardous Materials to become a component part of the Local Emergency Planning District Plan; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County's Hazardous Materials Emergency Plan has been reviewed and approved by the Florida State Emergency Response Commission for Hazardous Materials as meeting the criteria for such plans established by the Administrator, United States Environmental Protection Agency, and the National Response Team.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 9th day of January, 1990, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. Nassau County's Hazardous Materials Plan, dated October 26, 1989, is hereby adopted.
