repair said roads; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has requested disaster relief for the
citrus growers that experienced freeze damage in the same month;
and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County,

disaster relief monies so that the roads that were damaged by the


weather can be addressed.


