

RESOLUTION 90 -88

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 83-25, WHICH SET FORTH REGULATIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BEACH PERMIT STICKERS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 83-25; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution contained a provisions for the sale of beach permit stickers.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 10th day of April, 1990, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Resolution 83-25 shall be amended as follows:

1. Section 7 shall be deleted.

2. A new Section 7 shall read: The Clerk's office and each retail outlet shall be entitled to collect, for the sale of each annual and daily permit, an amount up to one dollar (\$1.00) for each annual and daily permit. Said charge shall be a handling charge and shall be deducted from the amount set forth in Ordinance 83-11, as amended. No retail outlet shall charge an amount higher than the amount set forth in Ordinance 83-11, as amended. Any retail outlet charging more than the amount set forth in Ordinance 83-11, as amended, shall forfeit the privilege

of selling said permits.
