

RESOLUTION NO. 91-19

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THAT A PROPOSITION
CALLING FOR AT LARGE REPRESENTATION WITHIN THE
COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICTS BE SUBMITTED TO THE
ELECTORATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 124.011, Florida Statutes, the
Board of County Commissioners may submit to the electors of the
county, a proposition calling for County Commissioners to be
elected at large; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes that the
voters should have the option to vote for five (5) County
Commissioners elected at large.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 13th day of November,
1990, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County,
Florida, as follows:

1. The Supervisor of Elections is hereby directed to place
on the ballot, for the general election to be held in 1992, as
follows:

Shall the five (5) members of the Board of County Commissioners
of Nassau County, Florida, be elected to office at large by
electors residing county wide?

2. No County Commissioner elected at the general election
which approves any revision shall be affected in his years'
office.


3. The at-large representation shall become effective as
