

RESOLUTION 91 - 20

A RESOLUTION TO THE FLORIDA CABINET OPPOSING
THE AES CEDAR BAY, INC., COGENERATION PLANT
PROPOSED FOR CONSTRUCTION ON THE BROWARD
RIVER IN NORTH DUVAL COUNTY.

WHEREAS, upon the request by various citizens of Nassau County, the Board of County Commissioners has been asked to voice its opposition to the construction by AES Cedar Bay, Inc., of a cogeneration plant proposed for construction on the Broward River in northern Duval County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the findings by the Federal EPA, said plant would emit large amounts of hazardous chemicals into the air; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes said emissions would further pollute the air in North Florida; and

WHEREAS, said plant would use approximately seven (7) million gallons of water per day pumped from the aquifer; and

WHEREAS, the St. Johns River Water Management District has imposed water restrictions upon the residents of North Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes it is not in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that said plant be permitted to be built.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 13th day of November,

1990, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The Board hereby requests the Governor and the Cabinet of Florida reject the request of AES Cedar Bay, Inc., to build a cogeneration plant on the Broward River in northern Duval County.


2. The Board further requests that, if the plant is allowed to be built, AES Cedar Bay, Inc., not be allowed to use any water from the Florida aquifer.
