

RESOLUTION 91 - 56

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING REPRESENTATIVE GEORGE CRADY'S ASSISTANCE IN ACQUIRING MANAGERIAL CONTROL OF THE STATE-OWNED PROPERTY ON THE SOUTH END OF AMELIA ISLAND, INCLUDING THE SHORELINE FRONTING SAID PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners petitioned the Florida Department of Natural Resources several years ago for managerial control of the State-owned property on the south end of Amelia Island; and

WHEREFORE, the Board still desires to have managerial control of the property and the shorelines fronting said property; and

WHEREFORE, the Board desires managerial control of this property in order to guarantee vehicular access to the southern tip of Amelia Island for the residents of Nassau County; and

WHEREFORE, Representative Crady has advised that he will renew the Board's efforts to obtain managerial control of the property owned by the State of Florida and the shorelines fronting said property.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 18th day of February, 1991, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:

2. The County Commissioners and staff stand ready to assist Representative Crady in that effort.


3. The managerial control of the property should include vehicular access for the south end of Amelia Island, and the right for vehicles to traverse the south end and Atlantic Ocean shorelines.
