

RESOLUTION 91 - 6

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SPECIFICALLY SETTING FORTH THE USE OF FUNDS DERIVED FROM THE ONE (1) CENT LOCAL OPTION SALES SURTAX.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, adopted Ordinance 90-20, which placed the local option sales surtax on the November, 1990, ballot; and

WHEREAS, the Board presented this option to the electorate of Nassau County to derive funds to meet Legislatively-mandated items.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 8th day of October, 1990, as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners, if the electorate approves the one cent local option sales surtax, shall use the monies for the following purposes:


(a) Sixty percent (60%) of the monies derived shall be used for the jail/administrative center.

(b) Forty percent (40%) of the funds shall be used for solid waste.

2. The funds received by the County from the unincorporated areas of the County shall only be utilized for the purposes set

forth in this Resolution.


