RESOLUTION 92 – 118

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THAT A PROPOSITION CALLING FOR SINGLE MEMBER REPRESENTATION WITHIN THE COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICTS BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORATE.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to <u>Florida Statutes</u>, Chapter 124.011, the Board of County Commissioners may submit, to the electors of the County, a proposition changing the election of county commissioners by districts only; and

WHEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners believes that the electorate should have the opportunity to decide whether to keep the election of county commissioners by district only or provide for election of county commissioners County wide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this <u>22nd</u> day of June, 1992, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County Florida as follows:

1. The Supervisor of Elections is hereby directed to place on the ballot, for the general election to be held this year, as follows:

> The Board of County Commissioners are presently elected by electors in each County Commission District only:

> Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, commencing in 1994, be elected to office by electors county wide and not by district only?

2. No County Commissioner elected prior to or at the general election which approves any revisions shall be affected in his years' office.

3. The election of County Commissioners by election county wide shall become effective as of the next general election in 1994.
