WHEREAS, the residents understand that they must pay for the construction and placement of new street signs reflecting this change, and





PRIVATE ROAD EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that DORIS A. GREEN, widow; NOLAN D. GREEN and SCARLETT D. GREEN, his wife; ROBERT B. GREEN and VICKI G. GREEN, his wife; and VERLIN C. HANSON and E. FRAULEIN HANSON, his wife, hereinafter called the grantors, do hereby dedicate and grant a Non-Exclusive Private Road Easement for ingress and egress through and over their lands being more particularly described as follows:

All that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land lying and being situate in the South 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 26, and the Southeast 1/4 of Section 27, all in Township 2 North, Range 23 East, Nassau County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

POINT OF REFERENCE is the intersection of the South line of said Section 27 with the Northeasterly right-of-way line of County Road No. 121 (formerly State Road No. 121), a 100 foot right of way, being a paved road; thence proceed North 22 degrees 11 minutes 55 seconds West along said Northeasterly right-of-way line, a distance of 413.67 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continue North 22 degrees 11 minutes 55 seconds West along said right-of-way line, a distance of 60.02 feet; thence North 69 degrees 26 minutes 22 seconds East departing said line, a distance of 660.52 feet; thence South 86 degrees 33 minutes 26 seconds East, a distance of 249.70 feet; thence South 83 degrees 22 minutes 47 seconds East, a distance of 852.45 feet; thence North 81 degrees 25 minutes 43 seconds East, a distance of 289.41 feet; thence North 46 degrees 37 minutes 01 seconds East, a distance of 347.34 feet; thence South 78 degrees 28 minutes 42 seconds East, a distance of 336.38 feet; thence South 71 degrees 34 minutes 34 seconds East, a distance of 627.70 feet; thence North 76 degrees 27 minutes 33 seconds East, a distance of 569.76 feet; thence North 82 degrees 15 minutes 30 seconds East, a distance of 140.98 feet to a point on the East line of said Southwest 1/4 of Section 26; thence South 01 degrees 10 minutes 51 seconds East along said East line, a distance of 60.40 feet; thence South 82 degrees 15 minutes 30 seconds West departing said line, a distance of 131.04 feet; thence South 76 degrees 27 minutes 33 seconds West, a distance of 583.90 feet; thence North 71 degrees 34 minutes 34 seconds West, a distance of 641.36 feet; thence North 78 degrees 28 minutes 42 seconds West, a distance of 301.58 feet; thence South 46 degrees 37 minutes 01 seconds West, a distance of 334.98 feet; thence South 81 degrees 25 minutes 43 seconds West, a distance of 316.21 feet; thence North 83 degrees 22 minutes 47 seconds West, a distance of 858.77 feet; thence North 86 degrees 33 minutes 26 seconds West, a distance of 235.28 feet; thence South 69 degrees 26 minutes 22 seconds West, a distance of 646.04 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

This Private Road Easement is dedicated in order to satisfy Nassau County Private Road Approval requirements.

The grantors do hereby covenant that they are lawfully seized of the aforementioned lands and that they have the authority to grant the Easement aforementioned.
