RESOLUTION 92 - 99

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 90-92, AS AMENDED, WHICH APPOINTED MEMBERS OF THE CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD AND SET FORTH PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES FOR THE BOARD.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to Ordinance 90-05 adopted said Ordinance establishing the Nassau County Code Enforcement Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 90-92, which appointed members to the Code Enforcement Board and set forth procedures and guidelines for said Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it necessary to amend Resolution 90-92, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 27th day of April, 1992, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida as follows:

1. VII. ORDINANCES

- 1. The inspector(s) shall have the authority to issue citations for violations of the following ordinances:
- (a) Ordinance 83-19, as amended Nassau County Zoning Ordinance;
 - (b) Ordinance 89-1 Amelia Island Sign Ordinance.
- (c) All building code ordinances adopted by the Board of County Commissioners applicable to building inspectors only.
 - (d) Ordinance 89-10 Nuisance Ordinance.
- (e) All fire protection and prevention codes adopted by the Board of County Commissioners. Said codes shall be enforced by the Fire Safety Inspector.

- (f) Ordinance 91-19, Beach Vendor Ordinance.
- (g) Ordinance 74-34, as amended, Animal Control Ordinance.
- (h) The authority to enforce the provisions of Florida

 Statutes, Chapter 403.413, known as the Florida Litter Law.
- 2. Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.
