WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida did establish Ordinance Number 92-14 providing for a process of naming and renaming streets in Nassau County, and

WHEREAS, the majority of Citizens of Nassau County currently residing on unnamed easement at end of Sandy Ford Road have requested that the street be renamed Thompson Lane, and


WHEREAS, the residents understand that they must pay for the construction and placement of new street signs reflecting this change, and


WHEREAS, the 911 Coordinator's office has forwarded the request to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration.
