

RESOLUTION NO. 93- 137

WHEREAS on September 13, 1993, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on the tentative budget and proposed millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes for the fiscal year from October 1, 1993 to September 30, 1994, and

WHEREAS, on September 27th, 1993 the Nassau County Board of County Commission held a public hearing to finalize the 1993-94 Budget and to adopt the millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commission of Nassau County, Florida, in special session duly assembled on the 27th day of September, 1993, adopted the following millage rates individually adopted for the fiscal year from October 1, 1993, to September 30, 1994:

The total millage rates for the County including the dependent districts and Nassau General represents a 1.29 percent decrease in property taxes over the rolled-back rate.
