

RESOLUTION 93-143

WHEREAS the Nassau County Anti-Drug Enforcement Grant Fund has received Federal pass-through grant funds from the State of Florida, representing a 75% of expenditures. Revenue and expenditures relate to year 2 drug grant.

WHEREAS these revenues were not anticipated in the 1992/93 budget for the Nassau County Anti-Drug Enforcement Grant Fund.

BE IT THEREFORE resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida in regular session, duly assembled on the 27th day of September, 1993, the following budget amendment pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 129.06(2)(d) be adopted:


