WHEREAS, as a result of his efforts, the candy was dislodged thereby preventing Mandi Rimes from having any serious results; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wish to acknowledge Ray Gillis' extraordinary actions and commend him for his concern for his fellow student.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 14th day of December, 1992, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:



It unanimously commends RAY GILLIS for the outstanding and caring actions that he took on
