

RESOLUTION 94 - 139

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO FOUR (4) LANE HIGHWAY A1A TO STRATTON ROAD IN CALLAHAN, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is in the process of four laneing Highway A1A from its intersection with Interstate 95 to Callahan, Florida; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) has been made aware that said four laneing will not be completed as far as Stratton Road in Callahan, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that the road should be four laned to Stratton Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 23rd day of May, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The Board will send a copy of this Resolution to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the Nassau County Legislative Delegation.
2. FDOT should four lane A1A to Stratton Road in Callahan, Florida.
3. The Board requests that FDOT advise the Board of their decision as to this Resolution.


