WHEREAS, Nassau County maintains a Comprehensive Plan which contains a recreation and open space element and maintains an ongoing public participation process.


WHEREAS, Nassau County is a duly constituted county qualified to meet the needs of its citizens, its neighbors and its visitors; and,


