

RESOLUTION 94 - 181

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 94-170, WHICH AMENDED RESOLUTION 87-21, WHICH ESTABLISHED A FEE FROM EACH TRAFFIC FINE COLLECTED BY THE COUNTY COURT WHICH IS DESIGNATED FOR THE COUNTY SHALL BE TENDERED TO THE SHERIFF FOR THE SCHOOL CROSSING PURPOSE; INCREASING THE FEE FROM \$4.00 TO \$10.00; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 87-21; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 94-170; and

WHEREAS, the Board has found it necessary to amend Resolution 94-170 for clarification.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 12th day of September, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Resolution 87-21 be amended as follows:


1. Prior to the division of traffic fine monies for the County and the City, ~~four (\$4.00) dollars~~ ten dollars (\$10.00) from each traffic fine collected shall be tendered to the Sheriff's department for the School Crossing Program. The six dollar (\$6.00) increase is to be taken from the 56.4% of the County's fines.

2. The monies to be disbursed by the Clerk pursuant to procedures set forth by his office.

3. This Resolution shall become effective on September 1,


