

RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 94-30

WHEREAS, Florida recorded 1,012 alcohol-related traffic fatalities and 22,595 alcohol-related traffic injuries in 1992; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers from the Nassau County Sheriff's Office, Florida Highway Patrol, Florida Marine Patrol, Florida Game and Fresh Water Fish Commission, Florida Office of Motor Carrier Compliance, and local police departments throughout the county have exhibited leadership in protecting the public from the DUI problem; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation, State Safety Office, and the Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services, Injury Control Program, are providing assistance in the development of community-based traffic safety programs with DUI emphasis; and

WHEREAS, citizen advocacy groups are continuing their efforts to reduce the incidence of driving under the influence in Florida; and

WHEREAS, the use of alcohol and drugs while operating motor vehicles and boats can best be combatted by local communities and an informed citizenry that understands the perils of operating motor vehicles and boats while impaired and the penalties that are imposed by Florida's DUI Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County do hereby proclaim December as

"DRUNK AND DRUGGED DRIVING PREVENTION MONTH"

in Nassau County and urge all citizens to become more cognizant of the dangers associated with intoxicated drivers and to support the fight against driving while under the influence of alcohol and other drugs on Florida's highways and waterways.
