WHEREAS, Nassau County recognizes this need for additional recreational opportunities; and,

WHEREAS, meeting the increasing demand for recreation opportunities can best be met with the addition of a boat ramp; and,


WHEREAS, Nassau County is a duly constituted county qualified to meet the needs of its citizens, its neighbors and its visitors; and,

RESOLVED, that Nassau County shall include improvements of a parking area and restroom facilities in addition to the boat ramp project in the amount of \$100,000.00 in plans for the current Fiscal Year as recorded in its five-year Capital Improvements Schedule portion of Nassau County's Comprehensive Plan providing State and/or Federal grants to fund such additions and improvement are received.


