WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County Florida did establish Ordinance Number 92-14 providing for a process of naming and renaming streets in Nassau County, and

WHEREAS, the residents understand that they must pay for the construction and placement of new street signs reflecting this change, and

WHEREAS, the 911 Coordinator's office has forwarded the request to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration, now

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED: THIS 14th DAY OF February¹⁹ 94, that the street curretnly known as **Seville Avenue** in Nassau County, Florida be hereafter referred to and known as **Osprey Point Lane**, and the County Engineer shall be authorized to erect any and all necessary signs indiciating said name.
