

RESOLUTION 95 - 83

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CONTINUED
APPROPRIATION OF FUNDING FOR PRESERVATION
2000.

WHEREAS, Nassau County's citizens have an interest and concern for the protection of natural lands; and

WHEREAS, Preservation 2000 is a ten (10) year program designed to acquire and, therefore, save Florida's best remaining natural land, and is Florida's most comprehensive land protection program; and

WHEREAS, Preservation 2000 offers an opportunity for a partnership between Nassau County and the State to protect environmentally sensitive lands and support implementation of the County's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County recognizes the importance of Preservation 2000 in enabling the implementation of conservation goals, growth management, and comprehensive land use plans.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 27th day of March, 1995, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, hereby urges the Legislature of the State of Florida to:
 - a. Appropriate funding for a sixth series of Preservation 2000 bonds.
 - b. Secure a permanent funding source for the remaining years of the Preservation 2000 program.

2. The Clerk of Nassau County is hereby directed to furnish copies of this Resolution to the members of the Nassau County Legislative Delegation.

3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
