

RESOLUTION NO. 95-84

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PRISONER REIMBURSEMENT TO THE COUNTY ACT

WHEREAS, the Board of county Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has a concern about the inmate population in county jails increasing dramatically representing a major portion of county budget expenditures.

WHEREAS, it is the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that inmates, who are financially able, pay the costs associated with their incarceration.


WHEREAS, reimbursement secured under this legislation would be returned to the General Fund of the county to be available for general fund purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 27th day of March, 1995 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:


1. The Board unanimously endorses the passage of the Prisoner Reimbursement to the County Act.


