

RESOLUTION NO. 96-201

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT ON HIGHWAY 17 FROM CRADY'S LAKE TO THE INTERSECTION OF A1A BE REDUCED

WHEREAS, the existing speed limit is posted at 55 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, the section of Highway 17 from Crady's Lake to the intersection of State Road A1A is heavily congested; and

WHEREAS, the existing posted speed limit of 55 miles per hour causes a safety problem for those traveling that road; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes it is in the best interest of the public's safety that the posted speed limit be reduced to 45 miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 30th day of September, 1996, as follows:


1. The Board of County Commissioners unanimously requests that the Florida Department of Transportation reduce the posted speed limit on Highway 17 from Crady's Lake to the intersection of A1A to a posted limit of 45 miles per hour.


