A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT JEFFERSON SMURFIT CORPORATION ALLOW THE USE OF HUNTING DOGS ON THEIR PROPERTY

WHEREAS, a great many citizens have enjoyed recreational hunting with their dogs for many years.


WHEREAS, Jefferson Smurfit Corporation has announced a ban on the use of hunting dogs on their properties.

3. A copy of this Resolution be sent to Jefferson Smurfit Corporation and that Jefferson Smurfit respond at their earliest convenience.


