A RESOLUTION OF THE NASSAU COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN SUPPORT OF A NATIONAL CEMETERY IN FLAGLER COUNTY

WHEREAS, The United States of America presently operates one hundred and fourteen (114) national cemeteries throughout the United States and Puerto Rico; and

WHEREAS, there presently exists within the State of Florida three (3) national cemeteries, all located in South Florida and/or on the west coast of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the fastest growing area in the United States is the northeast coast of Florida from Jacksonville to Daytona Beach, in which area no national cemetery exists; and

WHEREAS, there exists within the area an excess of 60,000 veterans.




