

RESOLUTION NO. 96-70

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING HOUSE BILL 881 AND ANY RELATED
SENATE BILLS OR AMENDMENTS RELATING TO PRESUMPTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has been made aware of proposed legislation through House Bill 881; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has been made aware that said proposed legislation provides that death or disability due to cancer suffered by a full time firefighter or paramedic employed by the state, municipality, county, port authority, special tax district or fire control district, is presumed to be accidental and suffered in the line of duty unless the contrary is shown by competent evidence.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is opposed to said legislation.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 8th day of April, 1996, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:


1. The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is hereby unanimously opposed to HB 881.


