**A RESOLUTION TO CHANGE THE
FOLLOWING STREET NAMES IN THE
TOWN OF CALLAHAN, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, the Northeast Florida Regional Planning Council recommended to the Town Council of the Town of Callahan, Florida, at its regular meeting of April 1, 1996, that the following changes are beneficial for the purpose of providing an efficient addressing method for the 911 system; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has requested "Brandies Avenue East and Brandies Avenue West; located in the city limits of the Town of Callahan", located in the N ½ of Section (29); Township 2N; Range 25E; be changed to "BRANDIES AVENUE"; due to a conflict in the 911 addressing grid; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has requested "Oak Street located in the city limits of the Town of Callahan", located in the N ½ of Section (29); Township 2N; Range 25E; be changed to "LITTLE OAK STREET"; due to a conflict in the 911-address grid; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Department of Public Safety has requested "the unnamed easement extending north off C R 108 (River Road)", located in the N ½ of Section (30); Township 2N; Range 25E; be changed to "RIVER PLACE"; due to a conflict in the 911 address grid; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Department of Public Safety has

requested "Ogilvie Road located in the city limits of the Town of Callahan"; located in the N ½ of Section (30); Township 2N; Range 25E; be changed to "NEW OGILVIE ROAD"; due to a conflict in the 911 address grid; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Department of Public Safety has requested "Oak Street located in the Town of Callahan"; located in the N ½ of Section (30); Township 2N; Range 25E; be changed to "OAK TRAIL"; due to a conflict in the 911 address grid; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Department of Public Safety has requested "U S Highway 1; located in the city limits of the Town of Callahan"; located in the N ½ of Section (30); Township 2N; Range 25E; be changed to "KINGS ROAD"; due to a conflict in the 911 address grid; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has requested "The road leading to Callahan High School in the Town of Callahan"; located in the N ½ of Section (30); Township 2N; Range 25E; be changed to "WARRIOR DRIVE"; and that the school receive the address designation "1" regardless of the address grid; and


WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners has received the City's favorable consideration of said recommendations by the Northeast Florida Regional Planning Council; and




