
WHEREAS, the following changes will establish a consistent street naming and addressing grid for all emergency systems as is intended by the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners as stated in Ordinance 87-18 and 88-23; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has requested that the road named "ST MARK DRIVE WEST"; located in the Lofton Creek Subdivision; located in Section 38 Township 2N; Range 27E; be changed to "SAINT MARK TRAIL"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, believe that these changes will be beneficial for the citizens of Nassau County.


