

RESOLUTION NO. 97-156

*A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, CONCEPTUALLY SUPPORTING THE PROPOSAL OF THE NASSAU COUNTY AQUATIC ASSOCIATION TO CONSTRUCT AN INDOOR SWIMMING POOL*

**WHEREAS**, an indoor pool would benefit Nassau County by providing: 1. recreation programs for all ages; 2. year-round swimming providing children with continuity and improvement in swimming lessons; and 3. day and evening swimming lessons; and

**WHEREAS**, an indoor pool would also provide the high school Swim Team with a place to practice, with the possibility of a Middle School team developing with year-round competition; and

**WHEREAS**, an indoor pool would provide the incorporation of "learn to swim" lessons at no charge for Physical Education Programs in the schools, thus greatly benefiting the childrens' bodies as well as their minds; and


**WHEREAS**, an indoor pool would provide a method to deter crime by giving children a place to go and, in addition, keeping physically fit in the process; and

**WHEREAS**, an indoor pool would provide exercise programs for the health of the citizens of Nassau County year round, especially for senior citizens, for needed year round indoor aquatic programs that are low impact on the body.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 28th day of July, 1997 that:
