

RESOLUTION NO. 97-190

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY PRESENTLY OWNED BY BILL AGRICOLA FOR UTILIZATION AS A MARINE PARK

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has unanimously adopted a policy to purchase and acquire additional boat ramps for the citizens of the county; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fernandina Beach is seeking the support of the county regarding the acquisition of real property located north of the Pogey Plant for utilization as a marine park; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County, Florida, to jointly apply for grant funds for the acquisition and creation of a marine park at that location.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 22nd day of September, 1997, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners approves and encourages the County Coordinator and his staff to meet with the staff of the City of Fernandina Beach to prepare an initial city/county plan for the acquisition of the property and obtaining of the necessary grant funds.

2. Said city/county plan be prepared and presented to both legislative bodies as soon as possible.
