WHEREAS on September 29, 1997, the Nassau county Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on the tentative budget and proposed millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes for the fiscal year from October 1, 1997 to September 30, 1998 and

WHEREAS, on October 13, 1997 the Nassau County Board of County Commission held a public hearing to finalize the 1997/98 Budget and to adopt the millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes,


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commission of Nassau County, Florida, in special session duly assembled on the 13th day of October, 1997, adopted the following millage rates individually adopted for the fiscal year from October 1, 1997, to September 30, 1998:

COUNTY TRANSPORTATION	.8857
PUBLIC HEALTH	<u>.2103</u>
TOTAL COUNTY WIDE MILLAGE	6.7321
MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT	.3224
REC & WATER CONSERVATION DIST. 1	.0000

The total millage rates for the County including the dependent districts represents an 8.01% increase in property taxes over the rolled-back rate.
