**WHEREAS**, the Amelia Island Museum of History provides an educational benefit to the students of Nassau County by instructing them in the County's fascinating history; and


**WHEREAS**, the Amelia Island Museum of History provides a cultural benefit of the citizens of Nassau County by preserving the rich heritage of the past; and


