

Resolution Number 98-155

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida did establish Ordinance Number 92-14 providing for a process of naming and renaming streets in Nassau County, and

WHEREAS, the majority of citizens of Nassau County currently residing on "**an unnamed road which extends south off of Hampton Road**", located in Section 7; Township 4N; Range 24; have requested the street to be named "**Wade Road (RD)**", and


WHEREAS, the residents understand that they must pay for the construction and placement of new street signs reflecting this change, and

WHEREAS, The 911 Coordinator's Office has reviewed the request in accordance with Ordinance Number 92-14, and has verified the request as acceptable and not in conflict with names already assigned and


WHEREAS, the 911 Coordinator's Office has forwarded the request to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration, now
