

RESOLUTION NO. 98-168

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION INSTALL "NO PARKING" SIGNS ALONG HIGHWAY US 17 FROM STATE ROAD 200 TO THE INTERSECTION AT PAGES DAIRY ROAD IN YULEE, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, has been made aware of the need for the installation of "No Parking" signs along Highway US 17 from State Road 200 to the intersection at Pages Dairy Road in Yulee, Florida; and


WHEREAS, this section of roadway is heavily traveled and parked vehicles along this section of roadway impede the orderly flow of traffic by blocking visibility; and

WHEREAS, the requested restriction will not adversely affect the immediate area with respect to available parking.

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida requests that the Florida Department of Transportation install "No Parking" signs on Highway US 17 from State Road 200 to the intersection at Pages Dairy Road in Yulee, Florida.


