

RESOLUTION 98- 71

WHEREAS the Capital Project-14th Street Phase II Fund has received a transfer from the Nassau County Impact Fee Fund, District 501 Transportation, to provide adequate funds for the signalization of 14th Street and Lime Street. Additional funding for this project was approved by the Board on February 23, 1998.

WHEREAS these revenues were not anticipated for the 1997/98 budget year in the Capital Project-14th Street Phase II Fund.

BE IT THEREFORE resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida in regular session, duly assembled on the 23rd day of March, 1998, the following budget amendment pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 129.06 (2) (d) be adopted:


