WHEREAS, the Amelia Island Museum of History provides an educational benefit to the students of Nassau County by instructing them in the County's fascinating history; and


WHEREAS, the Amelia Island Museum of History provides a cultural benefit to the citizens of Nassau County by preserving the rich heritage of the past; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 11th day of May, 1998, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:


