

RESOLUTION 99 - 140

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE DESIGNATION OF INTERSTATE 75 AS "FLORIDA HIGHWAY PATROL MEMORIAL HIGHWAY".

WHEREAS, thirty-seven members of the Florida Highway Patrol have died in the line of duty protecting motorists on Interstate 75 (I-75); and

WHEREAS, the members of the Highway Patrol serve the public on a daily basis and risk their lives in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners supports and commends the Highway Patrol and unanimously supports the designation of I-75 as the "Florida Highway Patrol Memorial Highway".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 8th day of November, 1999, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, resolves as follows:


1. The Board of County Commissioners unanimously endorses and supports the designation of I-75 as the "Florida Highway Patrol Memorial Highway".
