A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING MAY, 1999, AS COMMUNITY ACTION MONTH.

WHEREAS, the limited income continue to need opportunity to improve their lives and their living conditions, thus ensuring that all citizens are able to live in dignity; and


WHEREAS, Nassau County, the State of Florida, and the entire United States must continue to wage war on poverty by providing support and opportunities for all citizens in need of assistance.

1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby proclaims the




