

RESOLUTION NO. 99- 95

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION STUDY AND INSTITUTE TOLL FREE INTRA-COUNTY TELEPHONE CALLS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners on November 2, 1993 petitioned the Public Service Commission for extended area service between all Nassau County exchanges; and

WHEREAS, the Public Service Commission, in an order dated May 2, 1997, ordered that (1) Nassau County not be surveyed for non-optional extended area service; and (2) Alltel and BellSouth implement ECS on the Baldwin/Callahan route; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that toll free intra-county calling be studied and instituted; and

WHEREAS, the data and community of interest is now sufficient to warrant the studies and toll free intra-county calling; and


WHEREAS, the Board desires that the Public Service Commission consider toll free intra county calling for the area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 19th day of July, 1999 that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, hereby requests that:

1. The Public Service Commission conduct appropriate studies, and, at the completion of said studies, institute toll free intra-county telephone calls.

2. A public technical hearing be conducted in Nassau County, Florida.


