

**RESOLUTION 2000- 146**

**WHEREAS** the County has received FEMA grant 00-RM-xx-04-55-01-065, FEMA-1300-DR-FL passed through the State of Florida Department of Community Affairs for reimbursement of costs incurred during the Hurricane Floyd emergency of September 1999. Total received to date is \$95,880.74, representing \$82,629.24 from Federal government sources (75% of eligible expenditures) and \$13,251.50 from state (12.5% of eligible expenditures). Of the expenditures for which grant proceeds have been received, only \$42,796 was incurred in fiscal year 99/00, the remainder was incurred in fiscal year 98/99.

**WHEREAS** this revenue was not anticipated in the 1999/2000 budget for the County.

**BE IT THEREFORE** resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida in regular session, duly assembled on the 18th day of September, 2000 the following budget amendment pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 129.06 (2)(d) be adopted:
