

RESOLUTION 2000 - 157

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTES, SECTION 365.173, TO CARRY FORWARD UNSPENT MONIES IN THE WIRELESS EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM FUND FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes, Section 365.173(2)(a)(2), allows the County to carry over no more than thirty percent (30%) of any unspent monies in the Wireless Emergency Telephone System Fund for expenditures for capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised that there are unspent monies, less than thirty percent (30%), which may be carried over.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 29th day of September, 2000, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The sum of \$8,119.00 from the "911" system, Wireless Emergency Telephone System Fund, Account # 26251000-342411 "Wireless Fee", is hereby carried over to the fiscal year 2000-2001.

2. Said funds shall be utilized only for capital improvements for the "911" system.
