

**RESOLUTION 2000- 161**

**WHEREAS** the 911 Operations and Maintenance Fund has received and will continue to receive 911 wireless communication fees in accordance with the 1999 Florida Legislature Wireless Emergency Communications Act, Florida Statutes 365.172-174. Fees were collected by the state from customers starting August 1, 1999 and the first distribution was received by Nassau County April 25, 2000. The below amount represents the distribution periods March and April 2000.

**WHEREAS** the wireless fees received shall be used solely to pay recurring and non-recurring costs of providing 911 or E911 service, as provided by F.S. 365.173(2). Funds received will be transferred to the Sheriff who will maintain a separate accounting of revenues and expenditures associated with the wireless fees.

**WHEREAS** this revenue was not anticipated in the 1999/2000 budget year by the fund.

**BE IT THEREFORE** resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida in regular session, duly assembled on the 9th day of October, 2000 the following budget amendment pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 129.06 (2)(d) be adopted:


